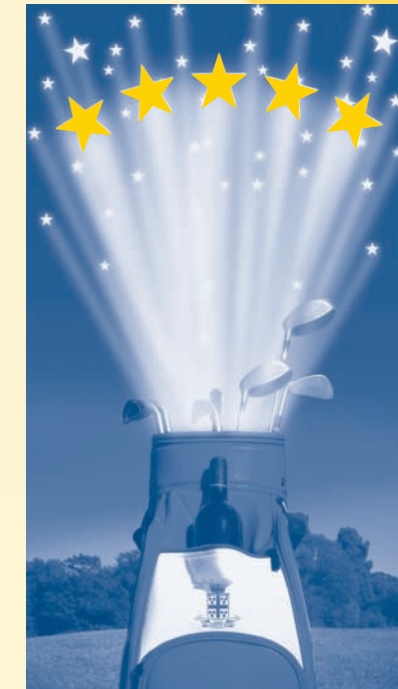

## A FIVE STAR EVENT!

On Sunday June 6th the Burnside Hospital Foundation is planning to raise \$120,000 for a special project, with a truly special event.

It is The Five Star Luncheon, in memory of the late Brian Fricker AM, to raise money for the redevelopment of the chemotherapy unit at the Burnside War Memorial Hospital.

Our hospital has been providing chemotherapy services from a number of "temporary" locations for some time, with the service currently being provided from 2 patient bedrooms, located in the shorter eastern end of our Von Rieben North ward on the first floor. This area, comprising 4 rooms, is to be renovated to provide a permanent self-contained space for cancer treatment services, with its own entrance. When complete, it will be named as the Brian Fricker Oncology Centre in honour of Brian's enthusiastic support for the Burnside War Memorial Hospital. He sadly lost his own battle with cancer in July last year.

A founding member of the Board of the Burnside Hospital Foundation, Brian Fricker played a key role in our recent successful building appeal. He was also well known and highly respected in Adelaide's business community – a director of the Fricker Carrington Group, a director of Southcorp for 18 years, past president of both the Master Builders Association and the Australian Institute of Company Directors, a member of the Liberal Party's South Australian fundraising committee for over 20 years, and a committed member of the PAC Old Collegians Association, Kooyonga Golf Club, and a number of community organisations.

## MOTHERS AND BABIES TO BENEFIT FROM NEW MONITOR

Over the last 9 months – a very appropriate time frame! - the Burnside Hospital Foundation has been raising funds for a new foetal heart monitor for the Maternity Unit at the Burnside War Memorial Hospital.

We are pleased to announce that we have now reached our fundraising goal of \$22,000 for this vital piece of equipment. Designed to provide obstetricians and midwives with early warning information on the health of the unborn child during labour, the new monitor also has the facility to simultaneously provide data on the well-being of the mother-to-be. With more than 600 new young South Australians having already entered the world at our hospital this financial year, the Maternity Unit is one of the busiest areas at the Burnside War Memorial Hospital, and will set yet another record this year for the highest number of births.
