Working collaboratively with co-located services for chemotherapy, radiology and pathology, the Burnside Hospital provides a comprehensive, on-site inpatient and outpatient breast care service.

Breast care nurses work across the Hospital, Breast & Endocrine Centre and the Brian Fricker Oncology Centre to provide continuity of care and a familiar face at each stage of treatment. The Hospital also supports the Breast & Endocrine Centre's team to collaboratively develop an individual treatment plan for each patient.

In-hospital nursing and allied health care

Our experienced and qualified nursing staff and visiting allied health practitioners will ensure that your post-operative care is matched to your particular requirements and in accordance with your surgeon's instructions. Our breast care nurses ensure there is streamlined care in relation to your pain, wound management and psychological support so that you are well-prepared for discharge, your ongoing recovery and are available to respond to any queries you may have.

What breast changes your Doctor should review?

A lump

Who should treat the problem?

Most problems can be treated by your General Practitioner however if a further opinion is recommended, further investigation is required, breast cancer is diagnosed or another breast problem needs treatment, then a referral can be made to one of the Visiting Breast and Endocrine Specialists at the Burnside Hospital.

The Burnside Hospital, in partnership with the Breast and Endocrine Centre, offers patients:

Urgent appointments for breast cancer, or suspicion of cancer, within 24-48 hours

Co-located radiology using state of the art mammography/tomosynthesis (Vacora biopsy available)

Same day results (unless additional, more complex testing is required)

Breast Clinician (doctor) for routine follow-up patient appointments

The ability to contact a Breast Care Nurse after-hours for advice and support

In-house Psychiatrist for ongoing psychological management and wellbeing

Treatment at the onsite Brian Fricker Oncology Centre

Individual case discussion at weekly multidisciplinary team meetings to ensure all patients receive the best evidence-based care and treatment plan
